The purpose of the NKE Scholarship is to provide partial funding to teachers toward study at Kodaly certification programs at Seattle Pacific University, Seattle. For 2011, NKE will provide between 1 and 3 scholarships for \$200 - \$500, based on availability of funds.

Applicants must currently teach music or be actively involved in music education. Applicants will be judged on their essay, and attendance and/or participation at NKE or OAKE events. Scholarship recipients will be asked to write a reflection of their experiences for the NKE newsletter or contribute to our fall Sharing Workshop.
